



## BECOMING A SC FBLA STATE MIDDLE LEVEL REPRESENTATIVE 2019 Requirements and Procedures

(Each middle level chapter may submit one candidate application.)

### Qualifications

- Currently be enrolled in 7<sup>th</sup> grade
- Currently hold an elective chapter office or serve on a FBLA chapter committee
- Have an overall "B" average (verification required)
- Have a good attendance record (verification required)
- Have no school discipline record (no discipline referrals)
- Must complete the "Bronze and Silver" Levels of the Middle Level LEAD program by **February 28, 2019**. (verification required)

### Appointment Rules and Procedures

- Candidates for Middle Level Representative will be appointed.
- Candidates for Middle Level Representative will be introduced during Friday's Opening General Session.
- Candidates for Middle Level Representative must attend the FBLA State Officer Candidate and Middle Level Representative Interviews/Rehearsal (**Time: 5:30 p.m., March 22, 2019**)
- Candidates for Middle Level Representative will meet with the FBLA Candidates at 5:00 p.m., Saturday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> for the Installation Ceremony Rehearsal.
- Middle Level Representatives will be announced during the Awards Banquet.

### **Duties and Responsibilities of Middle Level Representatives**

- Contribute to the officer team in planning projects, workshops, and conferences.
- Attend all State Executive Board meetings, the State Officer Training (**April/May 2019**), assigned chapter activities, the State Fall Rally, and the District and State Leadership Conferences.
- Submit a monthly report.
- Contribute ideas for improving South Carolina Middle Level FBLA membership.
