

STATE CHANT
COMPETITIVE EVENT GUIDELINES
2019 State Fall Leadership Rally—October 19, 2019
No Preregistration Required—Please review event guidelines prior to Rally

PURPOSE

The State Chant competition will demonstrate a team’s ability to motivate the state membership through a creative outlet. State chants are used at state and national conferences to demonstrate unity and pride in the state chapter. Through participating in this competition, members will achieve a sense of accomplishment as they strive to motivate the state membership to send a creative, unified message that we are proud of our participation in FBLA-PBL.

CONTENT

The State Chant competition must adhere to the following guidelines:

- ❖ Each chapter may select a maximum of **three members** to present a short chant.
- ❖ The maximum length of the chant is 60 seconds.
- ❖ The chant should be presented in such a way to get the audience to participate. (i.e. the team says the chant and then asks the audience to repeat and participate, etc.)
- ❖ This must be a South Carolina FBLA-PBL chant, not a chant for a local chapter.
- ❖ This is not a stepping competition. **(NO STEPPING ALLOWED)**
- ❖ This is not a cheer. **(NO PROPS, GYMNASTICS, ETC.)**
- ❖ This is not a rap.
- ❖ The chant will be judged during the second workshop session. This competition will take place in the Auditorium.
- ❖ The winning team will present their chant during the Closing General Session.
- ❖ Awards will be presented to the winning chant team. The winning chant will be posted on the SC FBLA Facebook page and website.
